


KLM Cityhopper: focussed operating carrier

Today:


- 1 base: AMS

- All line and base maintenance contracted out










CAMO as part of the Operator




Cooperation between CAMO and MRO's




- All maintenance under one roof

Cooperation for a common goal


- Continuous information exchange between CAMO and MRO's
- Exchange of occurrences
- Safety Consolidation Meeting
- Joint investigations
- Joint proactive risk analyses
- Joint replays

Challenges to manage safety in the CAMO

- Difference in (safety) culture between operator and MRO's
- Claim culture, with impact on mutual trust
- 'Schizophrenic' EU regulations: Quality vs Management System
- As a consequence: 'split' CAA oversight

So from an *Operator* perspective:

- Integrated SMS
- 1 Management system regulation
- Support the CAMO and MRO in transition
