Absence of transition period

Changes to F.S.

- transferred in ops before 02/01/2020 (easy)
 - Current reg. framework ad associated processes
- Initiated after 02/01/2020 (easy)
 - Current reg. framework ad associated processes
- And what about... the others? (not so easy)

Absence of transition period



- Use of
 - ATM/ANS.OR.B.010 (c)(1) "exemption to the procedure"
 - ATM/ANS.AR.C.030 (a)(2) "approval of procedure"

ATM/ANS.OR.B.010 (c) Change management procedures



- When the approved procedures referred to in point (b) are not suitable for a particular change, the service provider shall:
 - (1) make a request to the competent authority for an exemption to deviate from the approved procedures;
 - (2) provide the details of the deviation and the justification for its use to the competent authority;
 - (3) not use the deviation before being approved by the competent authority.

ATM/ANS.AR.C.030 (a)(2) Approval of CMP for functional systems



- (a) The competent authority shall review:
 - (2) any deviation from the procedures referred to in point (1) for a particular change, when requested by a service provider in accordance with point ATM/ANS.OR.B.010(c)(1).
- (b) CA shall approve the procedures, modifications and deviations referred to in point (a) when it has determined that they are necessary and sufficient for the service provider to demonstrate compliance with points ATM/ANS.OR.A.045, ATM/ANS.OR.C.005, ATS.OR.205, and ATS.OR.210, as applicable.

Timeline



- Approval on time for
 - Training of staff (ANSP and CA!)
 - Examples/shadow mode
 - So approval expect around summer 2019 (to be defined at local level)
- Use of approved procedure before 02/01/2020?
 - OK if still compliant with current reg. framework
 - Or, wait for 02/01/2020 for formal publication of deliverables
